Lambing

We have finished lambing down all the stud progeny with the June ET drop having been weaned at the beginning of October with an average weight of 42 kg. The august ET drop have not long been weaned, while the stud ewes have had their first natural lambing at 136% as well as producing embryos for our two ET programs. The most productive ewe in the stud has 12 lambs on the ground! These results have been a great shot in the arm for us to rapidly build the numbers in the stud and utilise the female genetics more effectively.
